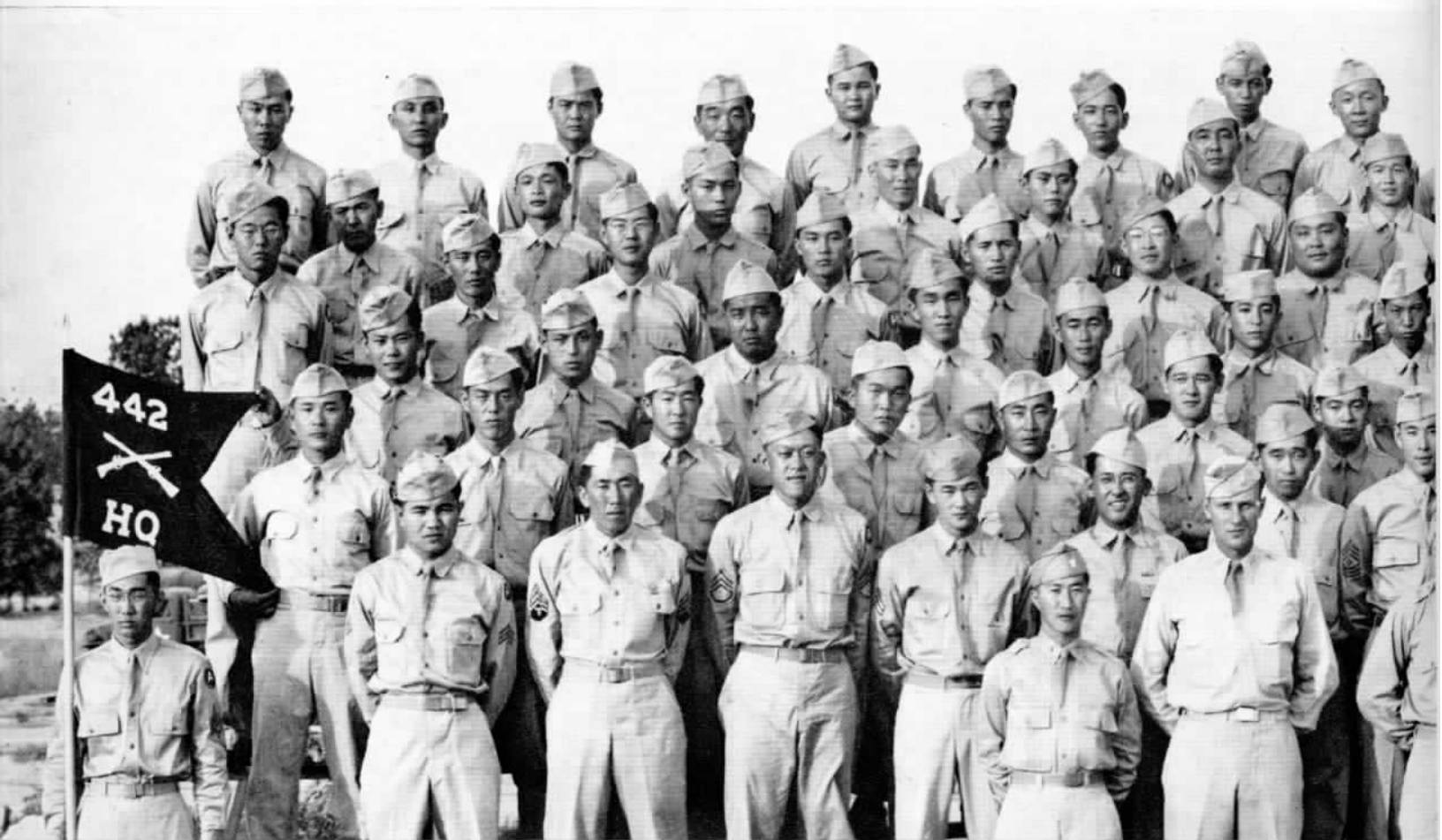

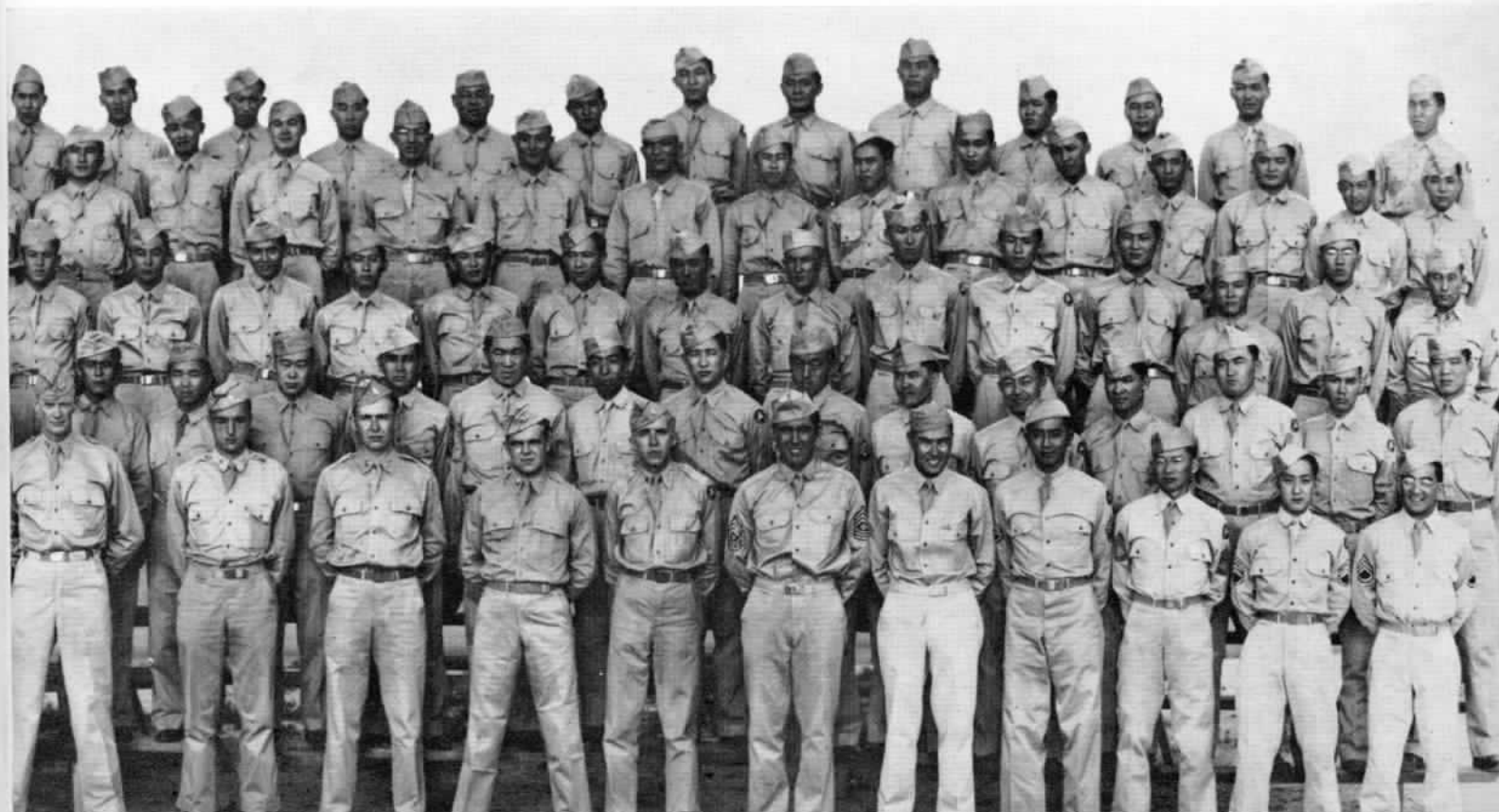

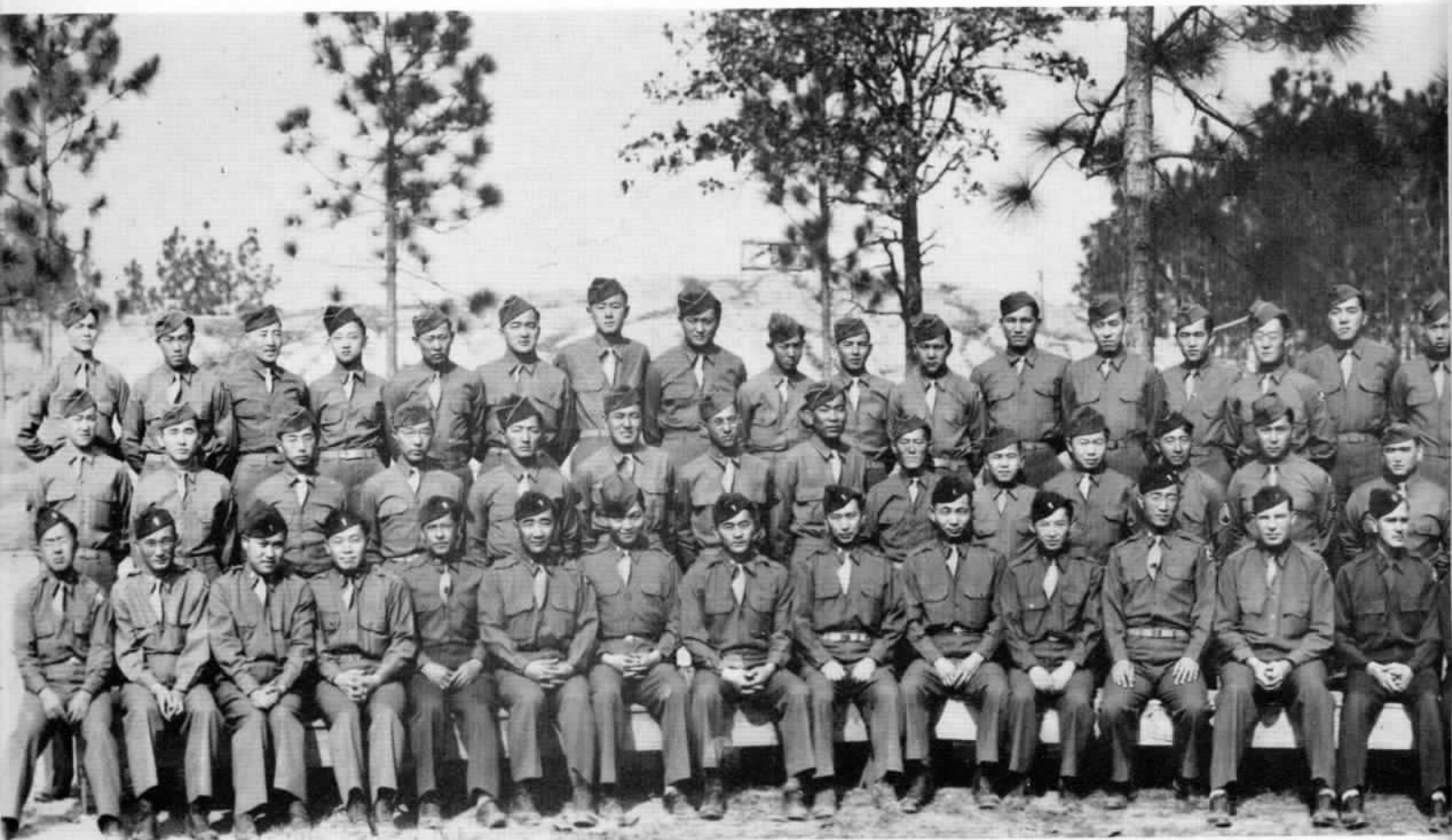

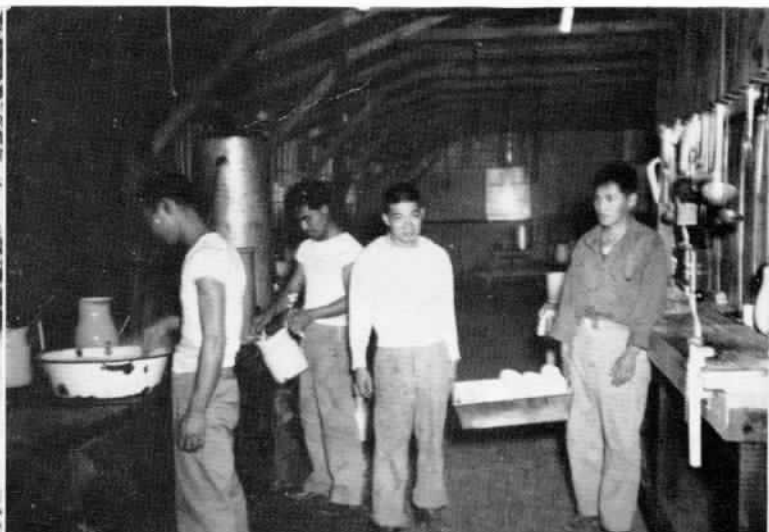
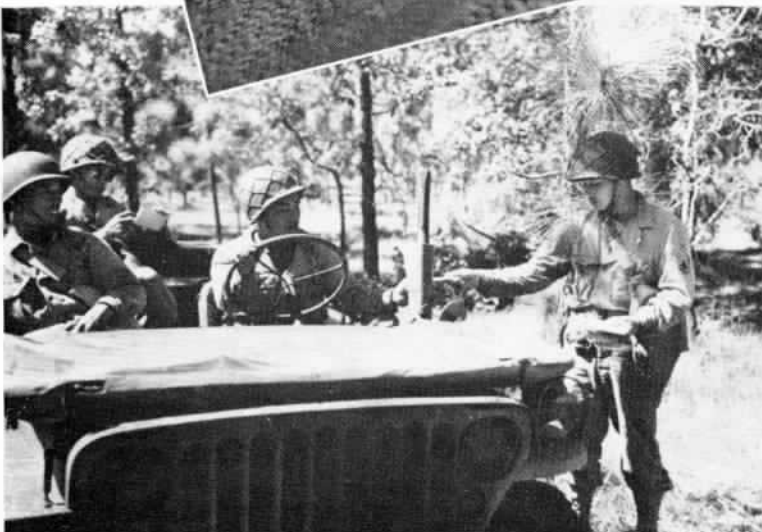
Someone remembered: It's a happy birthday for this soldier.
